Speech and Language

Overview: Teachers deliver specific speech and language interventions to children. All children are included in school performances and services.

Aim/Outcome: Children have increased confidence to speak and are given opportunities to speak in a wide variety of ways.

Subsidised trips

Overview: School trips and residentials partially subsidised to ensure access for all pupils.

Aim/Outcome: Raise aspiration and engagement of disadvantaged pupils. Improve behaviour. Cultural Capital. Create memories and experiences.

Uniform

Overview: School work with families to ensure access to school uniform. PE kits are provided to children who need them.

Aim/Outcome: Families supported with cost towards uniform. Children feel a sense of pride in their

Attendance

Overview: Disadvantaged Lead and Head of School monitor and act upon persistent absentees in half termly meetings. Good attendance is celebrated at the weekly celebration assembly.

Aim/Outcome: Increased attendance therefore chances of being academically successful are increased. Sense of pride and achievement. Learning gaps narrowed.

P4YP

Overview: Disadvantaged pupils may be supported by P4YP through well-being sessions, including family support work.

Aim/Outcome: Children are happier at home and at school, they are more able to access learning and focus. Families are supported in their parenting skills.



Breakfast Club

Overview: Free places and free breakfast

Aim/Outcome: Increased attendance and engagement in learning.

Curriculum Workshops

Overview: Contribution from PP funding goes towards subsidising the costs of curriculum enrichment workshops. For example, in topic, RE and literacy.

Aim/Outcome: to give a wide range of experiences to all children (Cultural Capital)

Interventions

Overview: Reading, Writing, Phonics and Maths interventions/preteach sessions for all pupils to narrow gaps in learning.

Aim/Outcome: To close the gap in learning and maintain consistent progress.

Reading

Overview: Provision of wide range of genres of high quality texts. Books purchased and given to disadvantaged children. Weekly lunch time Book Club, priority places given to disadvantaged children.

Aim: ensure all children have access to a wide range of reading material to facilitate reading for pleasure.

After school clubs

Overview: Disadvantaged pupils given free places as a priority in after school clubs. Pupils have the opportunity to experience a range of activities on offer e.g baking, STEM club, craft club, sports.

Aim/Outcome: Increase selfesteem, cultural capital. Improve fine and gross motor skills. Improve aspiration and engagement and improve behaviour.

Time to Talk ...

Overview: Disadvantaged pupils needs reviewed by class teachers regularly and time to talk sessions are made available where necessary.

Aim/Outcome: Improve social, emotional and behavioural attitudes. Children will be better equipped to access learning in the classroom after successful Nurture sessions.

Music Lessons

Overview: Pupils in KS2 have opportunity to be in a school band- 'Rocksteady'. School subsidises for our disadvantaged pupils.

Aim/Outcome: Raise self-esteem and confidence. Boost Well-being. Further enrichment to music education. Contributes to academic progress.
